Welcome to the Laguna Niguel Breakers. Everything you need to decide is here. Read it, complete the registration form at the back, and hand it to Coach Myers at practice.

Three dates to put in your calendar

Tryouts for new players: Tuesday October 6th, 2026

Season ends: Saturday June 26th, 2027

The 11s train alongside the 12s. Same nights, same coaches, all season. The 11s are on the court in front of the school and the 12s are on the upstairs turf. Practices run about two hours. Bring water, knee pads and court shoes.

Tryouts

Returning players do not try out. If your daughter played with the Breakers through the summer program, she keeps her place and nothing is required of her.

New players try out at a normal practice on **Tuesday October 6th, 2026**. No preparation needed, just arrive ready to play. Coach Myers places players on position, skill and commitment.

Schedules

Practice and tournament schedules are available at breakersvolleyballclub.com and can be downloaded straight to your phone, Android or iPhone. The 11s do not play the same tournaments as the older teams. They compete in the OCVH team tournaments, which run on their own schedule. Once the OCVH season dates are released in September, you will receive a separate package with the dates, the locations and the costs.



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What it costs

How to pay

Dues are paid directly to Coach Myers. Three ways:

Please include your daughter's name and the quarter with any payment, so it can be matched to her.

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Season commitment

Season commitment and refunds

Joining the Breakers is a commitment for the season. When your daughter takes a roster spot, Coach Myers builds the team around her and commits to court time, coaching and tournament costs for the whole season.

- Your first payment holds her spot and is non-refundable.
- Each quarterly payment is non-refundable once that quarter has started.
- If your daughter needs to step away for a valid reason, like an injury or a family move, talk to Coach Myers. We will work it out fairly.

We keep dues low by keeping the club full. Committing for the season is how we do that.

Tournaments

The 11s play in the OCVH tournament circuit. That is separate from the USA Volleyball schedule the older divisions follow, so the dates and the costs are different.

Tournament details come in a separate package

We expect the OCVH schedule in September. As soon as we have it you will get a second package with the dates, the locations and what it costs.

Nothing is owed for tournaments until that package reaches you. The totals above cover dues only.

Who we are

The Breakers are a small club, started by Scott Myers in 2012. We run teams at 11U, 12U, 13U and 14U. The club stays deliberately small, so every player gets real coaching, reaches her potential, and has a good time wherever we play.

Our goal

We are here to encourage your daughter to become a better volleyball player, build skills, team spirit, and confidence to carry her on and off the court.

We expect her to show up, work hard, be kind to her teammates, own her mistakes, and treat the other team members, officials and coaches with respect.

Practice

Showing up is what makes a player, and it is what makes a team. Tell Coach Myers about an absence as early as you can. If weather cancels a practice, you will be notified via the BAND app as soon as possible.

Communication

- BAND app. Day to day messages, reminders and schedule changes. Please turn notifications on.
- Email. Club updates, fees and forms.
- Text. Urgent things only. Coach Myers, 949-701-5484.

Tournaments

The 11s play in the OCVH tournament circuit, which is separate from the USA Volleyball schedule the older divisions follow. We expect that schedule in September and will send a second package with the dates, the locations and the costs.

Until that package reaches you, nothing is owed for tournaments.

Officiating

Every player officiates at tournaments. That can mean line judging, scoring or running the scoreboard. Players also shag balls during the other team's warm up unless a coach says otherwise. It is part of how we carry ourselves.

How we behave

We expect players and parents to represent the club well and to speak to people decently. Comments that run down teammates, coaches, opponents, officials or the club, online or in person, are dealt with directly.



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Playing time

Club volleyball is developmental and competitive at the same time. Playing time comes down to effort and attitude, attendance, skill development, volleyball IQ and what the team needs.

Roles change through the season as players develop, and every player has an important role. Success is not only time on the court. It is growth, contribution and commitment to the team.

If something is not right

Tell us. We would rather hear about a problem than have it build.

After a tournament, please wait one day before contacting a coach about a concern. It gives everyone time to think and cool down.
